LIABILITY RELEASE

RULES AND DISCIPLINE POLICY

We are excited to spend this time with your kids to learn about God and His Word, and grow closer together. To do so, we want to create a safe and caring environment for everyone. Negative behavior can make it difficult for children to enjoy the program and learn about Jesus. We want to address these issues in a positive way, by following rules that will help every child to be safe and enjoy our program. We also want to explain this behavior policy, so our team of adult volunteers who lead the program can work together with you as parents.

We have 5 rules. Each is intentionally written in a simple, clear way so that kids can understand and remember them. We will talk with them during the program about what each rule means and how to follow them.

<u>Rules</u>:

- 1. Ask your leader for permission if you need to leave the room (like going to the bathroom)
- 2. No getting water during the program (8:00 PM 9:30 PM; it is available for children before & after the program)
- 3. Listen when someone else is talking (this means no side conversations, no shouting out, and listening to the adult leaders during worship, large group time, small group time, and games/activities)
- 4. Participate during the program (this means no sitting out during worship or activities, either sharing during discussion or listening when others are sharing, and no distracting others)
- 5. Stay in the designated children's program space (this means not wandering around the parking lot or other buildings for their safety, or into other groups' Bible studies out of respect)

We also want to share with you the consequences if a child breaks any of these rules. There are 4 stages of consequences. The first time a child breaks a rule he/she will have a "Stage 1" consequence. If the child continues to break the rules, then he/she will have a "Stage 2" consequence, and so on.

Consequences:

Stage 1: A verbal warning will be given to the child by an adult leader. (No Card)

Stage 2: An official warning will be given to the child by an adult leader. If needed, a timeout will be given, where a "coach" will have a conversation with the child about why he/she is having trouble following the rules, and what he/she can do to successfully follow the rules. (Yellow Card)

Stage 3 & 4: A grounding will be given. The parent/guardian of the child will be called, and the child will be sent home for the night. In addition, the child will have to miss the next Friday program. For stage 4 grounding, the child will be grounded from the program for an extended period. There isn't a set amount of time that he/she will be grounded, but it will be decided based on the circumstances of the situation. (Red Card)

There are certain situations where a child will automatically be put on a "Stage 3" or "Stage 4" consequence. These include:

- Racial slurs
- Hurting others
- Stealing
- Destruction of property
- Willful disobedience
- Stopping any part of the program from being able to continue for the night

Basically, if a child does something unsafe, illegal or destructive, then they will be sent home for the evening.

While these rules and consequences may seem "heavy", they are important to ensure the safety of all children, and to create an environment where they can enjoy learning about God. We ask for your support by talking over these rules and consequences with your child to make sure that he/she understands them. Please sign and return the agreement at the bottom of the registration form to let us know that you have read and agree with our behavior policy.
