We are looking for a committed Christ-follower excited to serve the Lord, and students (6th – 12th grade) and their families, as a full-time Youth Ministry Director or Youth Minister. This individual will shepherd our youth (25-35 combined currently), lead a volunteer team (6-10 weekly adult volunteers currently), and equip parents and families that span across two congregations.

- Caring and visitation of students and families; equipping and partnering with parents
- Recruit and train Youth Ministry volunteers and leadership team
- Select and/or prepare curriculum for all programs under Youth Ministry
- Participate in local outreach and missions
- Preach in English worship service once a month
- Work with Children's Ministry to develop transition plan for students to Youth Ministry

- Strong relational and communication skills
